GOV'T TO ADDRESS NOISE POLLUTION

A GOVERNMENT Minister is of the view that there is need to urgently address environmental issues and other activities that create nuisances and health risks for the

public. Noting that one such matter is that of noise pollution, Minister of the Environment and National Beautification, the Hon. Trevor Prescod, signalled government's

commitment to "develop measures to address noise pollution" through the implementation of easily enforceable techniques, such as "curbing the operation of noisy equipment in residential com-

munities" during specific periods.

"This will be done through the appropriate legislative framework, taking into account the interest of all stakeholders
